Key 2018 developments

- EU databases (SIS II, VIS, Eurodac, ECRIS-TCN, ETIAS) and their interoperability
- Terrorism financing
- Radicalisation – HLEG-R (7/2017-5/2018)
- Illegal content online
- Strengthening the role of JHA Agencies

Latest ‘security package’ - April 2018

Legislative proposals:

- E-evidence Regulation and Directive
 - Directive to facilitate use of financial information to combat serious crime
 - Revision of Regulation 98/2013 on explosives precursors
 - Regulation to strengthen security of identity cards and residence documents
- + Recommendation to improve security of firearms export and import measures
