



Scholarships



ERA's scholarship programme aims to enable practitioners of law from EU Member States, candidate countries and potential candidates – be they judges, prosecutors, lawyers in private practice or in public administration – who would not otherwise be able to cover the costs to attend ERA events.

The programme was first launched in 2002 to celebrate ERA's tenth anniversary and initially focused on practitioners in Central and Eastern Europe. In 2012, to mark ERA's twentieth anniversary, the creation of the ERA Jubilee Fund allowed the scholarship programme to be widened to practitioners from all EU Member States, candidate and associated countries.

Depending on the applicant's financial situation and subject to funds being available, the scholarship will cover all or part of the cost of travel, accommodation and the participation fees.
